Conditions of entry:

- Artwork must be in 2D medium e.g., paintings, drawings, prints, digital images, photographs, and presented on a flat surface e.g., canvas, paper, bark

- You must include your name, contact details, artwork title and medium
- Entries close 5pm, 27 November 2023

Entry is free and the winner will be announced at an exhibition showcasing all artworks in early December 2023 – details to follow.
